DISABILITY INITIATIVES

DISABILITY STRATEGY

The NSW Department of Education's Disability Strategy sets out the plan for an education system that meets the needs of children and young people with disability. Programs offered by The Arts Unit support this priority area.

THE CONNECTIONS PROGRAM

The Arts Unit's Connections team shares strategies, information and resources with teachers to improve learning outcomes and engagement for students with disability. Collaborations with various organisations such as the Art Gallery of NSW, Museum of Contemporary Art and Sydney Theatre Company provide exciting opportunities for students and professional learning for teachers.



INCLUSIVE DANCE WORKSHOPS

July to August 2023

The D'Arts Inclusive Dance Workshops for students are led by the NSW Department of Education Arts Unit in collaboration with industry professionals.

This exciting workshop program is designed to give students with disability the opportunity to explore, discover and reach new physical limits whilst engaging with teachers and students from other schools.

The one day workshops are suitable for students in Years 3 to 12, and all disabilities are catered for.

During the workshops, students and teachers will have the opportunity to discover new forms of physical expression in an engaging and supportive environment.

SHINING STARS

July to September 2023

Shining Stars is a creative arts program for Kindergarten to Year 12 public school students with a disability. The program provides opportunities for students to engage in a relevant and meaningful arts education program that caters to the needs, interests and abilities of each student.

Students develop knowledge of the creative arts curriculum, life skills, performance skills and confidence as they explore creative and performing arts.

Students participate in a series of workshops where they can build creative arts skills and form friendships. The program culminates in exhibitions and live performances at the Campbelltown Arts Centre on 31 August and 1 September 2023.

D'ARTS ENSEMBLE (Schools Spectacular)

September to November 2023

The D'Arts Ensemble provides an arena style performance opportunity for students with disability from public schools across NSW. Participation offers the opportunity to play a significant role in showcasing the students' abilities in the performing arts to a wider audience.

Each year students audition and work with their own school group, other schools, industry professionals and support staff to create a truly spectacular arena item.

The D'Arts Ensemble is involved in both small and large scale rehearsals where up to 5,000 other performers come together in the lead up to the Schools Spectacular. The event is staged at Qudos Bank Arena on Friday 24 and Saturday 25 November 2023 and will be broadcast nationally.

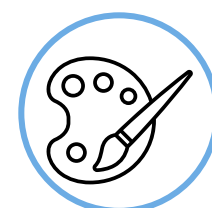
